Code of Conduct for Parents and Carers

As parents you are expected to:

- Positively reinforce your child and show an interest in our martial arts classes
- Do not place your child under pressure or push them into activities they do not want to do.
- Complete and return the consent form.
- Deliver and collect your child punctually before and after classes/events.
- Ensure your child comes to classes with correct unform.
- Ensure that gumshields are brought to classes when requested. Any child not in possession of the fundamental requirements will not be permitted to participate.
- Detail any relevant medical concerns or conditions pertaining to their child on the consent form. Any changes in the state of the child's health should be reported to the instructor prior to the activity.
- To inform the organiser prior to the activity starting if your child is to be collected early.
- Encourage your child to play by the rules, and teach them that they can only do their best.
- Ensure that your child understands their code of conduct.
- Behave responsibly on the side-line; do not embarrass your child.
- Show appreciation and support the instructors.
- Ensure your child is punctual.
- Be realistic and supportive please do not compare your child to others.
- Ensure your child has water to drink no fizzy drinks or sweets in class please.
- Accept the instructor's judgment and do not enter the field of play
- Promote your child's participation in playing sport for fun.

As a parents/carer you have the right to:

- Be assured that your child is safequarded during their participation in sport.
- Be informed of problems or concerns relating to your children.
- Be informed if your child is injured.
- Contribute to decisions within the club.
- Have any concerns about any aspect of your child's welfare listened to responded to

Any breaches of this code of conduct will be dealt with immediately by a senior instructor. Persistent concerns or breaches may result in you being asked not to attend games if your attendance is considered detrimental to the welfare of young participants.

The ultimate action should a parent/guardian continue to breach the code of behaviour may be the Kuk Sool Won ™ of Weston Super Mare instructor regrettably asking your child to leave the session, event or school.
